XX Conference of the Association of Colombianistas:
Global Colombias

August 3-5, 2017, University of San Diego, San Diego, California, USA

The Executive Committee of the Asociación de Colombianistas and the University of San Diego (USD) invite researchers, academics, educators and graduate students to submit proposals for individual papers and/or panels on the theme “Global Colombias.” Three dimensions are suggested here to orient the proposals: I. What are some of the most recent topics and approaches to (re)configurations of *lo colombiano* in international and global contexts? This dimension focuses on the examination of *lo colombiano*—as manifested in cultural production, communities of expatriate Colombians, etc.—located beyond the national territory, ranging from neighboring countries to other continents. II. How is Colombia studied in relation to other international contexts and expanding disciplinary perspectives? These studies will focus on realities and phenomena (historical, present, and future) in the national context—such as the armed conflict, articulations of the post-conflict, etc.—but analyzed with comparative approaches and/or interdisciplinary perspectives that include extranational aspects. III. What are some of the elements, influences, and instances of the foreign within Colombia that need additional or novel studies? While these three dimensions serve to indicate some general foci, proposals with different approaches and topics of study will be considered.

The Association of Colombianistas is an international organization dedicated to the study of Colombia in all areas of the humanities and social sciences. Proposals in English, Portuguese, and Spanish will be considered from the following disciplines and fields: anthropology, architecture, art and art history, visual and performance arts, political science, popular culture, cultural studies, gender studies, communication studies, peace and justice studies, ethnic studies, film studies, religious studies, philosophy, photography, geography, history and historiography, linguistics, literature, music and musicology, journalism, international relations, sociology, theology, among others.
